Director's Notes

We count everything at the library.

The number of time someone walks through the door: 44,242 (last year 43,029). The number of items checked out: 50,455 (last year 49,270).

Reference questions asked: 5,999 (last year 5,800)

How many people attended programs sponsored by the library:

4,780 (last year 4,351). But the number we're most proud of this year is 36% - that's the percentage of children who completed the Summer Reading Program this year. Last year it was 19%. We are extremely pleased to have a 34% increase in the number of children participating in Summer Reading. So not only did we have more children reading, but we had significantly more children stick with their reading throughout the summer. See! Numbers can tell a BIG story!

I Pads available for all ages to use while in the library. You can check out preloaded tablets that do not require any internet to use, and Leap Pads also. Board games and puzzles for all ages are a big hit too!
- In the children's department, there is a puppet stand with brand new puppets. There is a small variety of Spanish picture books.
- Supplies are always available for crafts at your leisure. Your kids have a variety of things they can do while at the library ~ unsure what, just ask!
- In the Adult Services area, there is a variety of Free things you can take with you: Coupons, Magazines, brochures, bookmarks and more.
- Books and other items can be purchased on our sale rack for .10¢ or \$1.00.
- We have a paperback trade rack ~ take a book and leave a book for free.
- There are paintings on display that you can borrow too!
- We offer Chilton's Repair Manuals that can be used while at the library.
- IF you need information copied to take, we can do that for you.
- Daily Local Newspapers and several other informational items can be read while you wait.
- There are Drop Boxes located in the front and back of the library for your convenience if you can't make it here before we close.
