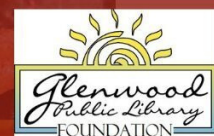

Library on the lawn had some great entertainment:

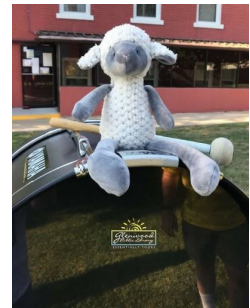
Tim Langholtz and Kelly Evans performed some **Beatles Music**.
